## Allotment Structures Policy

## Policy

Waverley Borough Council has confirmed that planning permission is not required for temporary allotment structures that meet the following requirements;

- Structure size 6' x 4'.
- Mounted on non-permanent base, e.g. railway sleepers
- Is easily removable.

## Conditions

- No more than one structure per plot.
- A structure is a poly tunnel or shed.
- The precise location of the structure on the plot will be at the discretion of the Grounds Manager taking into account ground conditions, and locations of other structures on plots to avoid overshadowing plots.
- The plotholder will be responsible for structure security.
- Maintenance responsibility lies with the plotholder.
- Structures will remain on site as long as they are adequately maintained.
- Unsafe or poorly maintained structures will be removed if the plotholder fails to make repairs after notice.
- The Council accepts no liability for loss, damage or theft from allotment structures.
- Permission in writing must be sought from the Parish Council prior to installation of the structure using the form in Annexe 1.
