CEMETERY DRAINAGE WORKS

Commencing mid to late May 2021

The Parish Council has ordered works to provide drainage for the new section of the cemetery located on the western side of the cemetery.

The works will involve:

- The cutting of lateral collector and carrier drains to a detention basin to be located by the western hedge.
- Installation of a post and rail fence around the detention basin.
- The digging of a drain from the detention basin to the southern boundary.
- The construction of a headwall on the southern boundary for the drain to discharge into the ditch.
- The detention basin will have a hydrobrake to slowly discharge the collected surface water via an underground pipe to the ditch on the southern boundary of the cemetery.
- There will be some machinery on site for the duration of the works.

The works will necessitate a temporary closure of public footpath 367 for five days (date to be advised). Works will be suspended during funerals.
