
Youth Council


Neighbourhood Plan

- Site assessment complete for sites up to 31 December 2017.
- Area of Special Visual Importance Review complete.
- Scoping Report for Strategic Environmental Assessment complete.
- Draft Plan to be presented to the Council July/August 2018

Planning Committee

- Considered 254 planning applications in 2017 - 2018
- Meets every three weeks
- WBC Local Plan adopted 20 February 2018
- Three Judicial Review challenges to the Local Plan
- Planning application for 1,800 houses at Dunsfold Park approved by the Secretary of State, but now subject to Judicial Review
