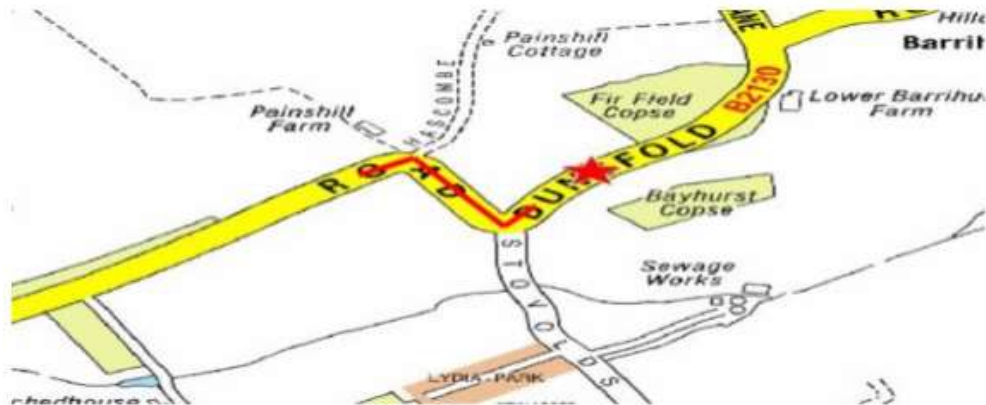

## Information for residents and businesses

Dunsfold Road, Cranleigh will be closed whilst we carry out our anti-skid works from Stolvolds Hill to the Access Road A281.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

The red line indicates the road closure and the area we will be working in.

A diversion will be in place during the road closure, please follow the diversion signs.

### Night works

Working overnight enables longer uninterrupted working before the closure has to be lifted for daytime traffic, and results in a shorter period of disruption.

### Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs.

### Parking

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles. Please park somewhere else otherwise your vehicle may be towed away to a nearby road.

### Noise

There will be some noise but we will try to carry out the bulk of the noisiest works before midnight.
