ASVI is a local landscape designation for an area considered to have high visual quality.

The main issues and values the designation seeks to address are:

- Where land is vulnerable to development pressure
- Protection is essential due to strategic visual importance
- Strong environmental reasons
- Preservation of the character of the locality
- Preventing coalescence

The areas identified to be included in this designation are:

- Snoxhall Fields
- Corner of Snoxhall Field
- Beryl Harvey Conservation Field including allotments
- Additional Fields to the west of the Downs Link path and the east of the Beryl Harvey Field
