





#### Q3 Should some existing communal areas of Cranleigh be designated Local Green Spaces? (Local Green Spaces are protected against development)













## Q9 Do you use a bicycle to get around in Cranleigh?







#### Q12 In determining acceptability of a housing development proposal how important is ease of pedestrian access to the High Street?







#### Q14 Do you think new housing developments should incorporate differing styles to break up the development outlines?





# Q15 In determining the acceptability of a housing proposal how important is the housing density?























#### Q25 If the NHS decided to discontinue funding for the existing Cranleigh village hospital would you want the hospital ownership to revert to the village community?


















### Q32 Should more be done to encourage start-up businesses in Cranleigh?
