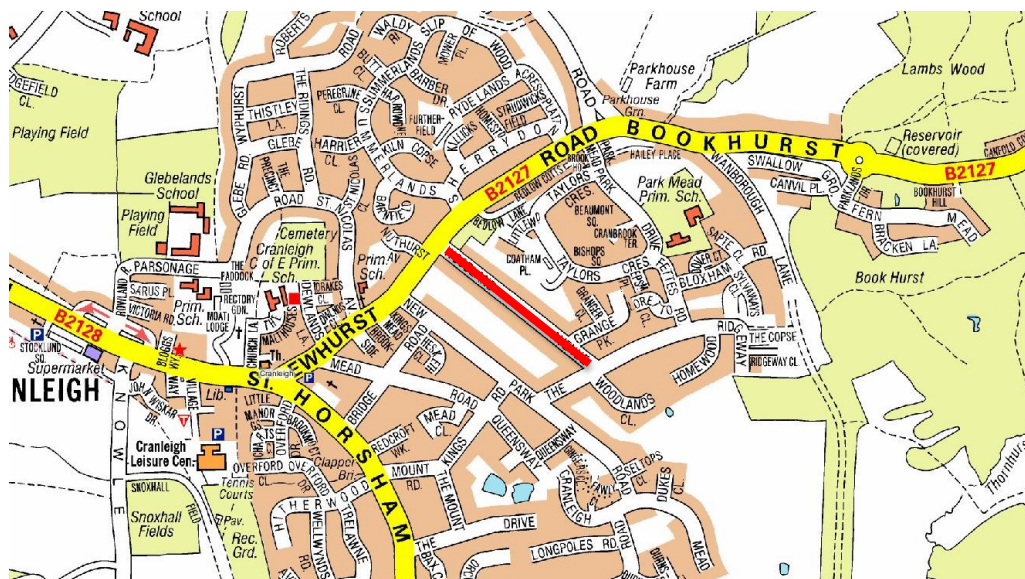

## Information for residents and businesses

Woodland Avenue will be closed whilst we carry out our surfacing works.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

The red line indicates the road closure required in order to complete the areas of resurfacing.

Surrey Highways have been given extra funding to repair roads which have suffered damage due to bad weather. The money has been used to form a programme of works called the 'Severe weather recovery programme' which we are delivering as quickly as possible to try to bring the worst affected roads in Surrey up to an acceptable standard. We are giving residents as much notice as we can, but as the programme is moving quickly we aren't always able to give as much warning as we would like. We hope you are pleased with the works.

### Delays in work

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles. Please park somewhere else otherwise your vehicle may be towed away to a nearby road.
