This was a survey of our young people to try to get a better view of facilities in Cranleigh after responses to questions about facilities for sports and play showed that the respondents were not involved in these activities.

The survey was introduced to the pupils with the information that telling 23% of the village population was under 18 and 24% over 65. We had heard from the over 65's and wanted to hear from them; that there were no right or wrong answers and to imagine themselves as time travellers, living in Cranleigh in 10-15 years hence; be realistic but anything was possible to suggest.

The pupils completed the surveys in a thoughtful way and the results show them to be a a group that lives in a place where they feel safe, but where there could be more spare time activities and specifically indoors for boys and outside for girls, with more opportunities for part time and later full time jobs locally.

They wanted places to be teenagers together and with activities more affordable and more spontaneous.

A large proportion called for "a proper cinema" – when asked what this meant, they said where you didn't have to book ahead and could buy popcorn!

Notes

'Importance' questions use a scale 1 (low) to 5 (high). So 3 is middling.

Glebelands had 55 respondents, the Youth Club 15, total 70.


Measures taken to avoid duplication: the age range, hence the survey population, were different.

The histograms are the combined results (of the Glebelands and the Youth Club surveys) and only include the responses which answered the question; 'no answers' are excluded.

1a How important is it to you to continue to live in a village like Cranleigh when you are older?

Glebelands result: just below middling importance (average = 2.8) with a fairly even spread between (1) and (3), and many in (4): 1: 22%, 2: 16%, 3: 25%, 4: 35%, 5: 2% (total 100%).

Youth Club result: average 2.9: 1: 7%, 2: 20%, 3: 33%, 4: 20%, 5: 13%, and one (7%) said 'zero' (total 100%). *Combined result:* average 2.8: 0: 1%, 1: 19%, 2: 17%, 3: 27%, 4: 31%, 5: 4% (total 100%).



Importance of living in a village like Cranleigh when older

The average is 2.8; the spread is fairly even with a small skew towards 'important'.



2a Are the heritage and character of the village and its surrounding countryside important to you?

Glebelands result: a higher average importance than to Q1a (=3.2) and slightly more homogeneous answers (ie less spread): 1: 2%, 2: 25%, 3: 35%, 4: 31%, 5: 9% (total 100%).

Youth Club result: marked skew towards 'important'. average 3.8: 0: 1 (7%) 1: 1 (7%), 2: 1(7%), 3: 0 (0%), 4: 4 (27%), 5: 6 (40%), not answered 2 (13%).

Combined result: average: 3.3: 0:1 (1%), 1: 2 (3%), 2: 14 (20%), 3: 19 (27%), 4: 21 (30%), 5: 11 (16%), not answered 2 (3%) (total 100%).

A higher average importance, at 3.3.


2b Should it be preserved?

*Glebelands:*65% want to go to university. 20% want to stay with friends. Other suggestions were proposed: at home, own house, the army, Australia, work.

Youth Club: with friends 53%, at home 13%, own place 13%, abroad 13%, no response 7%.



4 When you leave school what do you want to do in the next five years?

Glebelands: 78% want to go to Sixth Form College and nearly all wish to go on to university. Another 9% want to go to the Sixth Form College with an apprenticeship.

Youth Club: start work anywhere 47%, start work in Cranleigh 7%, apprenticeship 13%, sixth form 13%, no response 20%.

Combined: sixth form: 77%, apprenticeships 8% (but add 5 of those who said 'sixth form'), start work 14%, army 1%, no response 12%.




When you leave school what do you want to do in the next five years?

5 If you move on to Godalming College how will you get there?

Glebelands: All but 3 (95%) said 'bus', the 3 said 'car' (5%). 23 (42%) said 'car' as well as 'bus', whatever that means. Of the 'bus' people 7 would travel with parent or shared car.

Youth Club: no responses.




If you move on to Godalming College how will you get there?

Combined: Yes 80%, no 20%. Glebelands and Youth Club results were the same.

6b Do you feel that they are adequately maintained?


Combined: Yes 49% of the survey population (and 66% of the 6a 'yes's). The remainder are divided between 'no' (5), 'mostly' (3), 'could be better (2), 'litter' (1), and 'sometimes' (3). A few comments were made: more bike trails needed (3), sometimes overgrown (3), potholes (1), dog fouling (3), need more signs (1).

Combined: Foot 80%, bus 11%, bike 4%, motor bike 1%. Five did not answer.

7b If not, what would make it easier to be independent?

Glebelands: Bike 18, bus 8, moped 1. [I suspect they mean going further afield than Cranleigh.]

Youth Club: no responses.

8 Do you feel safe here when going about without your parents?


Glebelands: 98% said 'yes' though 4 want more street lights in alleyways (1 mentioned Bedlows Lane). The 2% said 'not after dark'.

Youth Club: 'yes' 93%, 'depends whether I'm on my medication' 7%.

9 If you plan to seek employment locally where would you expect to do your training?

Glebelands: 35% said 'not applicable'; 24% said 'university', 20% said 'don't know', 20% said 'in house', and 1 said 'the army'.

Youth Club: Guildford 27%, (1 said 'or Woking') which we took to mean at the College, the rest (73% were 'anywhere, 'yes', 'don't know' or no response.






What other facility for your education would you like to see in Cranleigh? (units are people responding)





Would you consider volunteering in Cranleigh (when >18) to build your work experience?







Combined: Yes 48 (69%), no 20 (29%), don't know 2 (3%). The Glebelands responses taken alone were slightly higher than this (yes=73%).






