1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

The work commitment apology of Cllr G Worthington was AGREED.

2. PUBLIC SESSION

There were no members of the public present.

3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest or changes notified to Members' Register of Interests.

4. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Council NOTED the following report:

- The Council had reported its concerns about anti-social behaviour at Snoxhall Fields to new Borough Commander Inspector Sam Adcock.

5. CLERK'S REPORT

The Council NOTED the following report:

- The Clerk advised that WBC have identified three trees at Snoxhall Fields that require removal within one month. She had circulated the information to Councillors and one Councillor had objected to the removal of the twin stemmed ash tree and would prefer to see it reduced to one stem. The Clerk sought the advice of the Arborculturalist who said that if the Parish Council decide to wait with these trees until after the September Council meeting, you are open to claims of negligence. The Council AGREED 5 in favour, 1 against to proceed with the removal of all three trees immediately.
- Waverley Borough Council are consulting on a review of their Street Trading Policy and would like comments by 18 September, before the next meeting of the Council. It was AGREED to delegate authority to the Planning Committee to respond to this consultation.

6. SNOXHALL FIELDS ADULT FOOTBALL PITCH IMPROVEMENTS

The Clerk advised that the Council had AGREED to appoint Centurian Services provided that the grant application to the Football Foundation was successful. The Clerk made the grant application to the Football Foundation who agreed funding for the goalposts at £1,200 but rejected the application for the fencing at £11,910 and deleted the application without advising the Council. The Clerk has appealed the rejected application and is awaiting a response.

The Council AGREED to await the outcome of the Football Foundation grant application, and if it is refused or partially funded, to draw the balance of funding from s106 funding up to £11,910 from WA/2016/1921.
